The meeting was called to order at 7:36 PM by Chairman Kean.

Review/Approve Minutes of the March 18th, 2025, Regular Meeting:

Motion to approve the March minutes was made by Fletcher Smith and seconded by Phillip Groth.

Vote: Nicole Bernabo abstained, all others in favor.

Expenses/Reports:

The Board of Education Reports for February and March were sent in advance by Superintendent Imma Canelli and reviewed by BOF members. The BOE report shows 73.84% of the budget has been expended as of the end of March 2026. There were no questions from BOF members.

The Board of Selectmen Report was presented by Magi Winslow, First Selectman. 74.31% of the annual budget has been expended as of the close of March. First Selectmen Winslow noted that a \$14,610.77 insurance settlement check from CIRMA came in to cover the remaining balance of lightning strike repairs to security system at Town Hall. Also noted: The Town is exploring fiber optic cable services for many of the Town's buildings which would come with financial help from the State of CT via grant funds.

The Treasurer's Reports were sent in advance by Karen Eseppe, Treasurer and reviewed by BOF members. The collection of property taxes is on track and going well. Nicole Bernabo inquired as to the status of the new pumper truck on order for the West Hartland Fire Department, Treasurer Eseppe noted current delivery status is July of 2027. Financing will be negotiated and put in place for the balance at time of delivery.

Nicole Bernabo made the motion to accept the Treasurer's Reports as presented, Tim Irwin seconded the motion. Vote: Unanimous.

Motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:00PM was made by Nicole Bernabo, seconded by Fletcher Smith, with an all in favor.
