Budget Line Items for the 2021 – 2022 General Government Budget were discussed.

To approve a request from “Breakaway Benefit” for a cycling ride to be held on May 1, 2021. Riders will pass through Hartland from 10am – noon, specifically Center St. from Barkhamsted Town Line to Granville Road, and South Road from Rte. 20 to Barkhamsted Town Line. This will be a supervised ride that obeys the “rules of the road” and all state traffic laws. A State Permit will be obtained once permission is given by Towns whose roads are involved in the ride.
