### Coronavirus Update – Town Offices

All Town buildings remain closed to the general public but are functioning well and appointments are available for those that might need them. The Library is looking to open on June 1, 2021. We are discussing opening other services/buildings as we look to our Governor and the COG for information.

Hartland Baseball/Youth Sports will open their Baseball Season in Hartland and will follow strict Covid guidelines in masking and safety distancing of players and spectators. Opening Day will be held April 4/24/21.

Mariner reports they are pleased with progress on “Tower 3” (South Road). Drawings are being completed as well as work on the northern drive entrance. IWC areas are flagged and will be inspected. Phase I environmental inspections are ongoing. Federal aviation approval for tower height is in process. The construction manager will be walking the site in the next few weeks. Geo tech engineer will be available June/July. Soil samples and design are set for approval and the foundation will be completed. The State of Connecticut wants this Tower up this current year – possibly in the fall or winter.

Work continues on the Nurses Building at Camp Alice Merritt via volunteers and donations. We have met with our Building Inspector.
