MEETING OF THE BOARD OF SELECTMEN
MONDAY, JANUARY 8, 2024

The meeting was called to order at 7:31p.m. by First Selectman Magi Winslow.
The meeting was held via Zoom.

Motion: Magi Winslow/Greg Sottile– Unanimous

Old Business

New construction will begin shortly at the Nellie B. West Building at Camp Alice Merritt. A Contract has been signed and a building permit is in the process. Work will continue through the winter season as weather allows.

To establish the “Hartland Housing Commission”. This Commission will consist of 7 members and will be a resource/advisory Commission assisting (by invitation) other Hartland Boards, Commissions and Residents. The Commission members will begin with a one-year term. The three Selectmen are currently appointed to the Commission. Interested residents will be considered to fill the open positions on the Commission. Commission members will focus on key areas, i.e., housing data, legislation (as it may affect the Town of Hartland), communication and other issues identified by the Housing Commission.

Motion: Magi Winslow/Scott Levan – Unanimous
To re-appoint Ellen Smith as a Regular Member to the Planning and Zoning Commission. Ellen’s term will begin on 3/12/24, following the end of her current term.

Scott Levan discussed Transfer Station plans for a new contract. The plan will be outlined and discussed at a special meeting of the BOS.
