THE LEGAL VOTERS OF THE TOWN OF HARTLAND, CONNECTICUT, AND ALL PERSONS ENTITLED TO VOTE IN TOWN MEETINGS OF SAID TOWN, ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED AND WARNED THAT THE ANNUAL TOWN MEETING OF SAID TOWN WILL BE HELD ON MONDAY, MAY 20, 2024, AT 8:00 P.M. IN MULTI-PURPOSE ROOM, HARTLAND SCHOOL, 30 SOUTH ROAD, EAST HARTLAND, CONNECTICUT, FOR THE FOLLOWING PURPOSES AND FOR THE TRANSACTION OF THE FOLLOWING BUSINESS:

- 1. TO CONSIDER AND ACT UPON THE ESTIMATED BUDGET FOR THE TOWN OF HARTLAND, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$8,168,976.00 AS SUBMITTED BY THE BOARD OF FINANCE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING ON JULY 1, 2024, AND ENDING ON JUNE 30, 2025, BOTH AS TO APPROPRIATIONS RECOMMENDED AND AS TO SOURCES OF REVENUE. (VOTER ACTION OF THIS ITEM WILL TAKE PLACE AT A REFERENDUM TO BE HELD ON WEDNESDAY, MAY 22, 2024, FROM NOON TO 8:00 P.M.)
- 2. TO CONSIDER AND ACT UPON AUTHORIZING THE BOARD OF SELECTMEN AND THE FIRST SELECTMAN AS ITS REPRESENTATIVE, TO ENTER INTO ANY AND ALL CONTRACTS AND AGREEMENTS IN THE NAME OF AND ON BEHALF OF THE TOWN OF HARTLAND WITH THE STATE OF CONNECTICUT AND/OR THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT FOR THE REPAIR, MAINTENANCE AND CONSTRUCTION OF HIGHWAYS AND BRIDGES IN THE TOWN OF HARTLAND.

TO CONSIDER AND ACT UPON AUTHORIZING THE BOARD OF SELECTMEN AND THE FIRST SELECTMAN AS ITS REPRESENTATIVE, TO SIGN ANY CONTRACT, CERTIFICATE, AGREEMENT, AMENDMENT OR ANY OTHER REPORT, FORM, STATEMENT OR DOCUMENT ON BEHALF OF THE TOWN OF HARTLAND CONCERNING THE OPERATION OF THE TOWN AND EXPENDITURE OF THE GENERAL GOVERNMENT BUDGET, INCLUDING WITHOUT LIMITATION; BRRFOC, COVANTA – BRISTOL, INC., BRISTOL FACILITY POLICY BOARD (BFPB), INSURANCE POLICIES, GRANTS AND RECYCLING CONTRACTS.

FROM THE TOWN CLERK'S OFFICE

Welcome June...flowers, cookouts, and Dog Licenses!

Each June every dog aged six months and older should be licensed in the owner's Town of residence. Dogs can only be licensed when current on rabies vaccinations and a certificate with expiration date must be presented each time your dog has received a booster vaccination.

To obtain the first license after a dog has been spayed/neutered, the owner must present a certificate stating the procedure was done. This information is often included on the veterinarian's rabies certificate.

Current Fees for Licenses:	Spayed/Neutered Dogs	\$8.00
	Intact Dogs	\$19.00

You may visit the Town Clerk's office in person, or you may mail your payment, copy of new rabies certificate (if applicable) and self-addressed postage-paid return envelope for your receipt and dog's tag.

An additional \$1.00 penalty is charged for each month after June when an owner fails to license a dog as required.

HARTLAND SCHOOL A SCHOOL OF DISTINCTION



We are excited to announce that Hartland School has been recognized as a **SCHOOL OF DISTINCTION** by the Connecticut State Department of Education for the 2022-2023 school year. Only the top 10% of schools in the state of Connecticut are eligible for this honor. Hartland School received this designation for HIGH PERFORMANCE in BOTH Reading and Math.

This is the second time in the past four years that Hartland School was recognized as a SCHOOL OF DISTINCTION. It also received this recognition in 2018-2019. Hartland School was one of only sixty-nine schools in the state that received this designation for both HIGH PERFORMANCE and GROWTH in BOTH Reading and Math.

The Connecticut State Department of Education identifies Schools of Distinction through the results of the Next Generation Accountability System. There was no accountability measure in place during the 2019-2020 school year or the 2020-2021 school year so schools were not recognized during those years due to COVID.

We are extremely PROUD of our STUDENTS and STAFF!! This is an outstanding accomplishment and a tribute to the hard work and dedication of our students and staff. The following is a list of Town Shelters available in a emergency situation – weather or other. The Emergency Management Office is located in the Hartland Town Hall. Emergency radio and services are dispatched from this location. Call (860) 653-6800 for information.

<u>First Church in Hartland</u>

2 Hartland Blvd., East Hartland

This is the first Shelter the Town will open working with the First Church. Shelter has a full kitchen, handicap accessible with a handicap ramp and a generator. Heating and Cooling station. Shelter Manager is Brett Watson 860 916-4453.

Nellie B. West Building at Camp Alice Merritt

167 Hartland Blvd., East Hartland

This Town Shelter would open as we gauge the situation and see if any other shelters would be needed. Town would staff, but volunteers would be needed. Handicap accessible and handicap ramp.

Bethany Lutheran Church

116 Walnut Hill Rd., East Hartland

This is a larger Shelter and would be used if there is a Town-wide emergency that would involve several days. This Shelter would be used in conjunction with Nellie B. West House. Handicap ramp at this location, shower and elevator available. (860) 653-2005

<u>West Hartland Community Building (Library Building)</u> 61 Center St., West Hartland

This is a Town Shelter located in West Hartland. The Town would Staff the Building, but would need volunteers to help with food, etc. Handicap accessible and shower available. (860) 238-4401
