February 11, 2026 – Regular Meeting Minutes

Members Present: Chair Enos (Steve) Stevens, Vice Chair Charles (Chuck) Constable, Tom Daukas, Margaret (Peggy) Kawa, and Brian Kershaw

1. The Hartland Inland Wetlands Commission Regular Meeting was called to order at 7:04 pm by Chair Stevens. Commission Members present were verbally confirmed by Chair Stevens.
2. The minutes from December 10, 2025 Regular Meeting were reviewed. **Chair Stevens made a motion to amend the minutes as follows:**
Under Members Absent – add Wetlands Enforcement Officer Scott Eisenlohr
Item 10 B – Amend the sentence to include, “Recording Secretary Irwin to follow up with Hilary Wilson to check if the Wetlands application is complete and able to be uploaded to the Town Website as a PDF.”
Vice Chair Constable seconded. Ms. Kawa abstained. Motion passed.

 - A. Review and approve 2026-2027 Budget – **Margaret (Peggy) Kawa made a motion to set the Fiscal Year 2026-2027 Budget of \$4,030, which is the same as the 2025-2026 Fiscal Year. Chair Stevens seconded. All in favor; motion passed.**
 - B. There is questionable illegal activity on 2 Foxbrook Road. A driveway has been cut through the property which crossed wetlands. There are two driveways cut on the property. It is unsure if WEO Eisenlohr has issued a Cease and Desist on this property location.
6. **Town Attorney Cases**
 - A. 265 Center Street, West Hartland – Darrel Pecott – There was no update provided as of the time of the meeting.
 - B. 532 Hogback Road, West Hartland – Ryan Sheehan – There was no update provided at the time of the meeting.
7. **Violations**
 - A. Michael Renzullo – North Hollow Road and Old Town Road – At the December 10, 2025 meeting there was concern about unregulated activity. Chair Stevens and Vice Chair Constable walked the property a couple days after the meeting and found nothing violating wetlands. Therefore, no Cease & Desist was issued.
